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
Letter from the CEO



In 2022, Quantix began climate reporting with our first CDP Report for our 2021 operations. Quantix is committed to evaluating climate-related issues through our governance and management processes and will be incorporating the lessons learned from the reporting process into broader risk management and implementation strategies.












Scope 2 (Electricity) (in MTCO2e)

Since 2019, Quantix has acquired 9 companies. We used estimated data for all companies acquired between 2021 and 2023, even if we did not yet own them, so we can compare data year over year. Our operational reach increased from 2021 to 2022 with the acquisition of two new companies. We also opened four new warehouses - one of which was 1.1. million square feet - which accounts for the increase in scope 2 emissions in 2023.



As a supply chain services company, recycling various materials is a key method in which Quantix is able to minimize negative environmental impact.

To evaluate our recycling performance, we track our total tons recycled each year and identify additional opportunities for education and operational changes to increase our numbers year over year.



Pellet Loss Prevention

We are committed to pellet loss prevention, containment, and clean-up and have protocols in place to manage pellet loss including:

High volume facilities designed to contain pellets in the buildings with goal of zero pellet loss in the environment

ABOUT QUANTIX

- Rigorous floor sweep protocols and stations to ensure any stray product is immediately contained
- Stringent tank wash processes include the use of separators to ensure pellets do not escape into public water systems
- Skillfully planned methods to contain pellets during operational activities such as outfitting trailers with catch bags and including catch pans for transloading
- Pellet recycling partnership to ensure this material can be repurposed and recycled for another use

Industry organization commitment



As part of **Operation Clean Sweep blue**, Quantix has committed to additional training, reporting, inspections and procedural enhancements focused on pellet loss prevention, containment and clean-up. Quantix will also help inform new OCS literature surrounding its best management practices in this regard.



Strategic Partnerships and Events



Reducing emissions at one of our largest facilities





As a corporate partner with Truckers Against Trafficking, we provide training to all employees in recognizing the signs of human trafficking in the logistics industry.







Volunteer Time Off

Performing forest restoration work in New York City







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Ethics and Compliance

Proper governance is an essential part of our business that is used to manage risk, comply with regulations, build trust with stakeholders, and improve performance. Quantix is committed to upholding the highest standards of governance to ensure that our employees, customers, and partners are ethical, compliant, and secure in their business dealings with us.

The Quantix Anti-Corruption Guidelines and Procedures are a critical part of Quantix's commitment to conducting business with the highest standards of business ethics and integrity. Strict compliance is expected and required. The Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA) is a U.S. law, but it applies to Quantix, its non-U.S. affiliates, and to foreign nationals working for Quantix. Also, while these Guidelines focus on compliance with the U.S. FCPA, we must also comply with all applicable anti-bribery laws wherever Quantix does business outside the U.S.

Ethics, safety, and fraud reporting

Quantix has a reporting platform designed to empower individuals to anonymously, or openly, report unethical or unsafe behavior. We encourage use of this platform when reporting concerns to managers or other members of leadership are not an option.

This platforms allows us to proactively address issues and safeguard our people and organization in general.



Company Code of Conduct

Quantix's code of conduct defines our basic standards for conducting business on a daily business with each other, customers and vendors. The code of conduct and company core values work together to help strengthen our company culture and provide a guide for conducting business.

- 3. We are **responsible** for company property.

Cybersecurity

At Quantix, it is a principle of our code of conduct to be responsible with company property. This includes following security protocols and protecting our data, including our customer data.

We have a dedicated security team at Quantix along with our platform partners and consultants. Our team provides annual cybersecurity awareness training for all internal users to ensure that employees are up to date with our security practices and standards.



Supplier Management

We recognize the important role suppliers play within our sustainability initiative. Engagement with our industry partners strengthens our mission and is a necessary step in the achievement of our sustainability goals. To promote responsible procurement, we've successfully launched a Supplier Code of Conduct and Supplier ESG Survey over the last year. Our new Supplier Code of Conduct (SCOC) provides a framework for proper business conduct with our suppliers as well as expectations in the areas of:

We've engaged with more than 100 strategic suppliers via our Supplier ESG Survey to identify their goals and look for areas of opportunity and collaboration.
